They will be presented in an environmental way - with a number of texts being read at once - allowing attendees to negotiate their own relationship with the material.

The evening includes a conversation with John Barylick, a lawyer, and author of "Killer Show: The Station Nightclub Fire, America's Deadliest Rock Concert." Janet Cooper-Nelson, Chaplain at Brown University, and Jonathan Saltzman, an investigative reporter at The Boston Globe.
